Rules of play

The aim is to bring forth artists that you really love to listen to and like to discuss; while having fun you will be improving your speech techniques. The main objective of this mission is to create an interesting **presentation/discussion** that people will enjoy **participating** in.

1. Select an English-speaking artist or a band of your choice. Pick a song or two that you would like to share with the rest of the group. Do not pick a song with lyrics that defy analysis (she loves you, yeah, yeah, yeah).
2. Get the lyrics from the internet or the album sleeve. Copy **the lyrics**, pictures and **all the difficult words in the songs (and don't forget to explain the words)**.
3. Prepare an analysis of the lyrics that involves the situation in the song, message, attitude and personal reflections as well as some **exercise** (besides the discussion of the lyrics) for the eager audience to participate in e.g. a competition of some kind.
4. Prepare lots of stunning gossip about the artist as well as a biography including greatest hits etc.
5. Use enough time to make the presentation/discussion an interesting one that does the artist justice! Around 25-30 minutes should be sufficient. Do not make the mistake of reading a manuscript in front of the class, use the floor, move around, talk freely. Four people in each group.

Note: needless to say you have to be present each lesson during the preparations and show us the progression of your work! Computer room 1 is reserved for 2A, 2B, 2C and 2D during this period!

The material for the presentation/discussion should be made in several copies so that everyone has it and thereby, regardless of the fact that somebody might be ill, can go through with the presentation on time, failure to do so will result in an IG for the entire group.
