

PROVOCATIVE FORUM

You will all be divided into four (2D five) groups. Each group will be responsible for a class dealing with provocative issues, issues that you are interested in or like to discuss with others. Capital punishment, Drug problems, abortion, euthanasia, sex, eating disorders and more could be appropriate topics for one (or two) article(s) that you read, think about, create questions to, and finally bring to class and most importantly **lead a discussion** about. One or several articles or texts will be in the centre of your group's provocative forum. Your job will be to lead an intelligent discussion trying to involve all your classmates. If they fail to speak you have failed in creating an interesting ground for discussion.

I am going to give you fairly free hands when it comes to the form of your provocative forum. It is however absolutely essential that you keep a high, intelligent level of both content (the topics, articles you are discussing) and the form (correctness of language and performance). You have **25-30 minutes** at your disposal!

Each forum will present at least ten good, useful words with explanations in English. This could be done on the whiteboard or, **preferably**, on a sheet that you have neatly copied to the group.

Look for articles and texts through TMG's website (the English department) and in ordinary newspapers and magazines such as *Newsweek*! Happy hunting!

Teacher's friendly advice: you have only two lessons to prepare so arrange to meet outside of classes. If you fail to appear (or come unprepared) on your presentation date you will not have the opportunity to do it later on! So make an effort and I'm sure your forum will be **provocative, intelligent, memorable and exciting!**
